TEXTILE **RE-DESIGN** Russian historical decoration and Italian contemporary design Exhibition was proposed by Renata Pompas, Teacher of the Digital Textile Design, annual course in AFOL Milano with AFOL Moda. She involved her Design students in important, international experiences with the Russian Federation to create an interesting partnership between Italian and Russian Cultures. A small sample of these Textiles was exhibited at the Museum of Kaunas, by TEXERE at the ETN conference last September. 2011. "The year of Italian language and culture in Russia and of Russian language and culture in Italy", these young designers of Digital Textile Design, Milan, were invited to reconsider, in contemporary style, some of the most important fabrics of the "Agitational Textiles" (Editor's Note: See A. Richard Horrock's book, Handbook of Technical Textiles P.44 text & images on Google) derived from the different textiles in various Russian Collections.

A small textile collection has emerged from this interpretation that now represents not only a simple pattern of repeated texture or quotation, but proposes a very real and modern re-interpretation that aims towards a rich commercial application into the market place.
